18. Do Something for Others

- A. Champion: Cindy Maxwell
- B. What we do: Go out of our way to do something special for another
- C. Who does it: All who choose to participate
- D. How often we do it: Twice each year
- E. When we do it: Christmas Season & Mid Summer (Christmas in July)
- F. Where we do it: During a church service, and throughout the community
- G. Why we do it: Fellowship
- H. Who we do it for: Church members over the age of 80, homebound, or in a skilled care facility
- I. How we pay for it: The members who participate pay for their activity
- J. How we do it:
1. Church records and the Pastor shall be consulted to identify those who qualify. Cooperation and assistance of the church secretary is vital to this step.
 2. A card bearing the name and contact information each person is prepared by the champion and helpers
 3. These cards are passed through the congregation during a church service, and all who wish to participate may select and remove as many cards as they wish.
 4. The participant is asked to do something special for the people named on the cards chosen. A nice lunch and other gifts of time, fellowship and companionship are more desirable than gifts of material things.
