### 16. Meals for people in Need

- A. Champion: Florence Lowe
- B. What we do: Produce meals and package them in freezer containers
- C. Who does it: Church members, directed by the champion
- D. How often we do it: As needed, about twice a year
- E. When we do it: Whenever the freezer is empty
- F. Where we do it: Church kitchen
- G. Why we do it: To provide a hot meal for those in need
- H. Who we do it for: The hungry, the shut in, those in need.
- I. How we pay for it: Cash and food donations
- J. How we do it:
1. Food is prepared, packaged, dated and frozen in single-serving containers, TV dinner style, and stored in the chest freezer set aside for the purpose in the Fellowship Hall
  2. Leftover food from pot lucks, wedding receptions and other events providing suitable leftovers are considered as additions to the menu
  3. Whenever the Pastor or other church member becomes aware of the need for a hot meal, one or more of these prepared servings are given to those in need.
